Keywords: Please provide 4 to 6 keywords.

Text Formatting: Manuscripts should be submitted in Microsoft Office Word file typed in Times New Roman font with 1.5 spacing.

Acknowledgment: Acknowledgment of people, grants, funds, etc. should be placed in a separate section before the reference list. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.

Other information:

1. All tables and figures are to be numbered.
2. Tables and figures should always be cited in text in consecutive numerical order.
3. For each table and figure, please supply a caption (title) explaining the components.
4. Identify any previously published material by giving the original source in the form of a reference at the end of the table caption.
5. References should be in this form-
