FYUGP RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Regulations will be known as THE UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS RELATING to B.A./B.Com./BBA/ B.Sc./BCA 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM **(FYUGP)** WITH SINGLE MAJOR under the New Curriculum and Credit Framework effective from 2023-2024 academic session, by the University of North Bengal, herein after, referred to as the University. Will be applicable only to full time Under Graduate Programs.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

1. *A Certificate after completing 1 year (2 Semesters) of study in the chosen field.*
2. *A Diploma after 2 years (4 Semesters) of study in the chosen field.*
3. *A Bachelor's Degree after 3 years (6 Semesters) Program of study in the chosen field.*
4. *A Bachelor's Degree (with Honours/Honours with Research) after 4 years (8 Semesters).*

COURSE STRUCTURE

- a) TWO SEMESTERS, WITH 40 CREDITS, FOR EXIT OPTION WITH A CERTIFICATE.
- b) FOUR SEMESTERS, WITH 82 CREDITS, FOR EXIT OPTION WITH A DIPLOMA.
- c) SIX SEMESTERS, WITH 124 CREDITS, FOR EXIT OPTION WITH A DEGREE.
- d) EIGHT SEMESTERS, WITH 160 CREDITS, CULMINATING IN A DEGREE IN HONOURS.
- e) EIGHT SEMESTERS, WITH 160 CREDITS, CULMINATING IN A DEGREE IN HONOURS WITH RESEARCH.

EACH COURSE WILL BE OF 2/3/4 CREDITS (WHEREVER APPLICABLE), AND THE MARKS DISTRIBUTION WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- i. MAJOR COURSE (MAJ) - 75 MARKS EACH - 4 CREDITS
- ii. MINOR COURSES (MIN) - 75 MARKS EACH - 4 CREDITS
- iii. ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES (AEC) - 50 MARKS EACH - 2 CREDITS
- iv. MULTIDISCIPLINARY COURSES (MDC) - 75 MARKS EACH - 3 CREDITS
- v. VALUE ADDED COURSES (VAC) - 75 MARKS EACH - 4 CREDITS
- vi. SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES (SEC) - 75 MARKS EACH - 3 CREDITS
- vii. INTERNSHIP/APPRENTICESHIP (IARD) - 50 MARKS EACH - 2 CREDITS
- viii. RESEARCH PROJECT/DISSERTATION (IARD) - 225 MARKS EACH (APPLICABLE ONLY IF THE STUDENT CHOOSES TO PURSUE HONOURS WITH RESEARCH) - 12 CREDITS

At the time of admission, a student will identify a Major Course in which he/she/transgender will concentrate. Apart from the Major Course he/she/transgender will have to select two (2- A & B) Minor courses. He/she/transgender will also have to select Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC) courses, Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Value Added Courses (VAC), and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) from the provided pool of choices.

Detailed Credit Distribution Structure for B.A./B.Com./BBA/B.Sc./BCA

For the purpose of credit determination, instruction is divided into three components:

- **Lectures (L)** - Classroom lectures of one-hour duration. (**L**) is the number of one hour Lectures per week.
- **Tutorials (T)** - Special, elaborate instructions on specific topics (from Lectures) of one-hour duration. (**T**) is the number of one hour Tutorials per week
- **Practical's (P)** - Laboratory or field exercises in which the student has to do experiments or other practical work of two-hour duration. (**P**) is the number of two hours Practical's per week.

This can be written in symbols as: $C = L + P/T$, where **C is the credit weight age for a particular course.**

General guidelines

- i. A student pursuing a subject as a Major Course, will have to opt for SEC in the Major subject.
- ii. Two Minor Courses must be different from the Major Course.
- iii. Three Multi disciplinary Courses (MDC) to be chosen from a pool of courses.
- iv. Practical/Tutorial: Every Major and Minor Course will have one Practical/Tutorial. Wherever there is a Practical, there will be no Tutorial and vice-versa.
- v. A student will have to study two papers each from two Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), and two papers of Value Added Courses (VAC).
- vi. **SEC, VAC, AEC, MDC**, and Vocational Courses – Respective UG-BOS will frame the syllabi.

Guidelines for Four Year Under Graduate Program with Honours with Research

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation in the major discipline under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College in the eighth semester. The research outcomes of their project work may be published in peer-reviewed journals or may be presented in conferences/seminars or may be patented.

The College offering a 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research) must have the required infrastructure such as the library, access to journals, computer lab and software, laboratory and/or other required facilities to carry out experimental research work, and at least two permanent faculty members who are recognized as Ph.D. supervisors.
